- Confidential medical exams to assess if a health problem is work related
- Diagnosis and treatment of work-related medical conditions
- Screenings for exposure to work-related hazards, such as asbestos, lead, and other toxic substances
- Social work services to address disease-related personal and family issues, including one-on-one counseling and monthly support groups
- World Trade Center Health Program services for 9/11 workers and volunteers
- Assistance with Workers' Compensation and other benefits
- Coordination of care with specialty practices throughout the Mount Sinai Health System

We partner with employers, unions, and other organizations to promote and maintain safe and healthy work environments. Our team of physicians, industrial hygienists, and other certified health and safety professionals have provided effective solutions to occupational health and safety issues since 1970. Our services include:

- Integrated occupational safety and health programs with health promotion activities.

- Respirator fit testing and clearance examinations

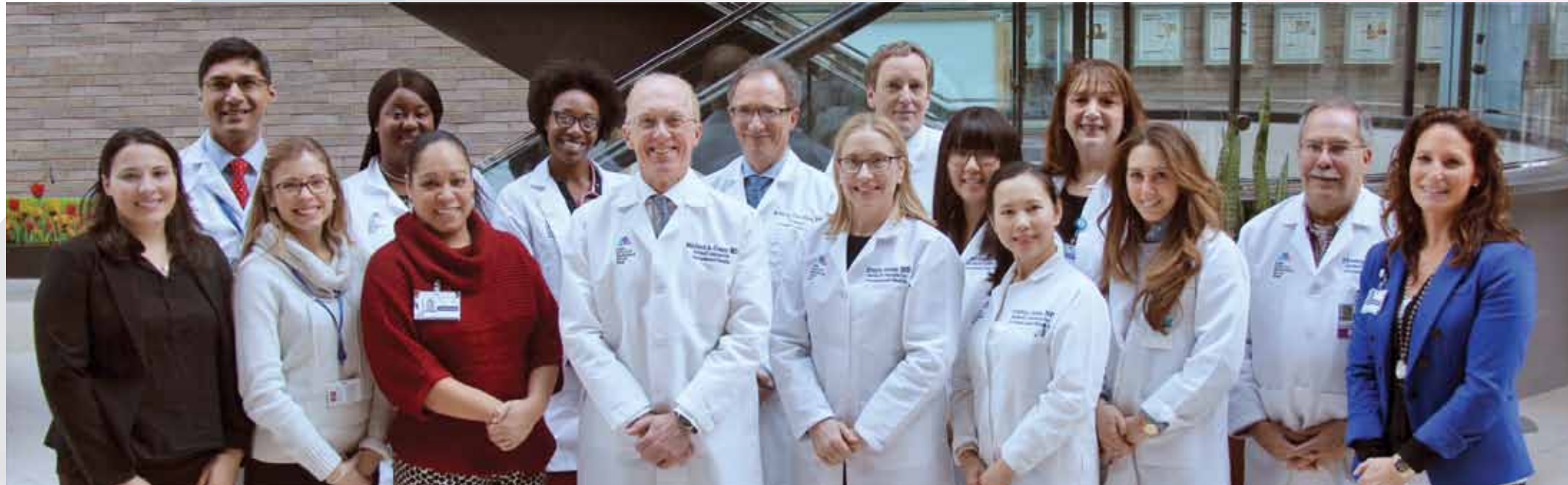
